

#### **Relaunch of the International Forum**



Cardinal Pietro Parolin, Secretary of the Vatican State, together with some 30 Catholic-inspired organisations represented in various international agencies in New York, Paris, Rome, Strasbourg, Vienna, Geneva, Brussels, Nairobi, Madrid and Addis Ababa as well as the apostolic nuncios in charge of the Holy See's Mission in these cities, participated in the meeting of the International NGO Forum which was relaunched with a new modality. The President General represented WUCWO, which will be particularly active in the areas of Family and Education.

## Regional Conference of Latin America and the Caribbean



The Conference was held in Antigua, Guatemala (October 26-29). It was organised by the Regional Vice President, Imelda Escobar, with the cooperation of the other Board members from the Region. In the light of the problems of women and the family in the Region, and encouraged by the Word of God and the teachings of Pope Francis, nearly 100 women from 10 countries and 22 different organisations worked and studied guided by the theme: "Family, seed of a humanised society." ### Migration and trafficking



Together with the Talitha Kum network and the other institutions that make up the Committee of the International Day the Eradication of Trafficking, WUCWO co-organised a seminar on "Migration and Trafficking" at the LUMSA University in Rome on 28 November, with some 200 participants, mostly The President people. participated together with 20 young Nigerian immigrants living in her own city. She also spoke on 1 December, at a meeting organised by the Women's section of the Dicastery for the Laity, Family and Life, entitled: "Francesca Cabrini, patron saint of immigrants: a saint for today".

### "Let us be at stake"

"Let us be at stake" is a national campaign against the risks of gambling. It is an initiative born in Italy in 2012 to raise awareness among people and institutions on the real characteristics of gambling in Italy and its social, economical, and health consequences. Its task consists also in making proposals to regulate the phenomenon, providing data and information, catalysing the commitment of many subjects that - at national and local level - are mobilised for the same ends. Italian Catholic Action is one of the promoters of the campaign.



# Venezuelan Catholic Action celebrated its 90 years





On November 18, Venezuelan Catholic Action celebrated its 90th anniversary with a Eucharist presided over by His Excellency, Apostolic Nuncio Mons. Aldo Giordano. Next, the President, Nelly Franchi de Madrid, recalled the history and the challenges of today's Venezuela, which is undergoing a profound crisis. She also encouraged to always have in mind the challenges posed by Pope Francis, who calls for a greater lay leadership to overcome poverty and exclusion, and achieve a world of justice, truth and peace.



One year before the next General Assembly, WUCWO Board met in Rome from 20 to 24 November to define the contents and approach of the Dakar 2018 General Assembly, which will be held from 15 to 22 October, under the slogan: "WUCWO Women, Carriers of "living water" to a world which thirsts for Peace." It will have a "synodal" style and the SEE, JUDGE and ACT method will be used. All information will be sent in January to each member organisation, as stated in the Statutes.
